- Groundbreaking for the new headquarters in Sinzing Jakobssiedlung, which will comprise 650 sqm of office and laboratory space

Having made itself a name by supplying primarily the German automotive industry with its individual consulting and development services, the young and innovative Regensburg company B-Horizon GmbH decided to start its further expansion with a new construction. The new building in Sinzing is a consistent step to meet future requirements. „Innovation and customer orientation are the cornerstones of our corporate philosophy as well as the driving forces of our continuing growth“, says founder and CEO Mohammad Kabany.

On occasion of the groundbreaking ceremony at the construction site in the Jakobssiedlung of Sinzing on May 6th, the 1st mayor of Sinzing, Patrick Grossmann, and B-Horizon founder and CEO Mohammad Kabany, met with builder Armin Zeiler and the architects Karl-Heinz Heitzer and Kathrin Wutzlhofer. Furthermore, Andreas Unsicker and Marcel Hartung of the company InoTexx GmbH joined the ceremony as future neighbors of this newly built industrial site in Sinzing.

Due to new contracts and the mid-term goal of entering the Chinese market, a further growth of the team of presently 15 employees is likely to be forthcoming. The investment in the construction of an own company building will create space for up to 35 employees as well as technical laboratories.

The move from the present office in Regensburg to the new site is scheduled for next year and will only be of a short distance of few kilometers. “We wanted to stay in this region, last but not least for the sake of the stability of the team” said CEO Mohammad Kabany, “The region of Regensburg has increasingly developed to become one of Germany’s top business locations. As a founder, I have experienced perfect conditions here, with a high industry density, and many innovative service companies.”

While the office expansion will allow the creation of new vacancies, the establishment of the additional business division “Sensors” shall be a strategic move, and essential part of the future headquarter. With the development of a new, innovative sensor system, for implementation in

the automotive industry and beyond, it is B-Horizon's ambition to take part in Bavaria's and Germany's future technology leadership.

The existing team of experts, most of them with long-standing experience in the microelectronics and automotive industry, is united in their passion for technology and innovation. Kabany points out: "The years of experience of our employees and their highly specialized knowledge build the basis of our innovative business model."

B-Horizon's expertise includes international business relations with automotive manufacturers and suppliers as well as project management, quality management and the development of ASICs (Application-Specific Integrated Circuits) and FPGAs (Field Programmable Gate Arrays). „Our customers especially acknowledge our combination of start up's advantages, such as agility, flexibility and speed, with the professionalism and structured work environment of an established benchmark company.“, adds Mohammad Kabany.
